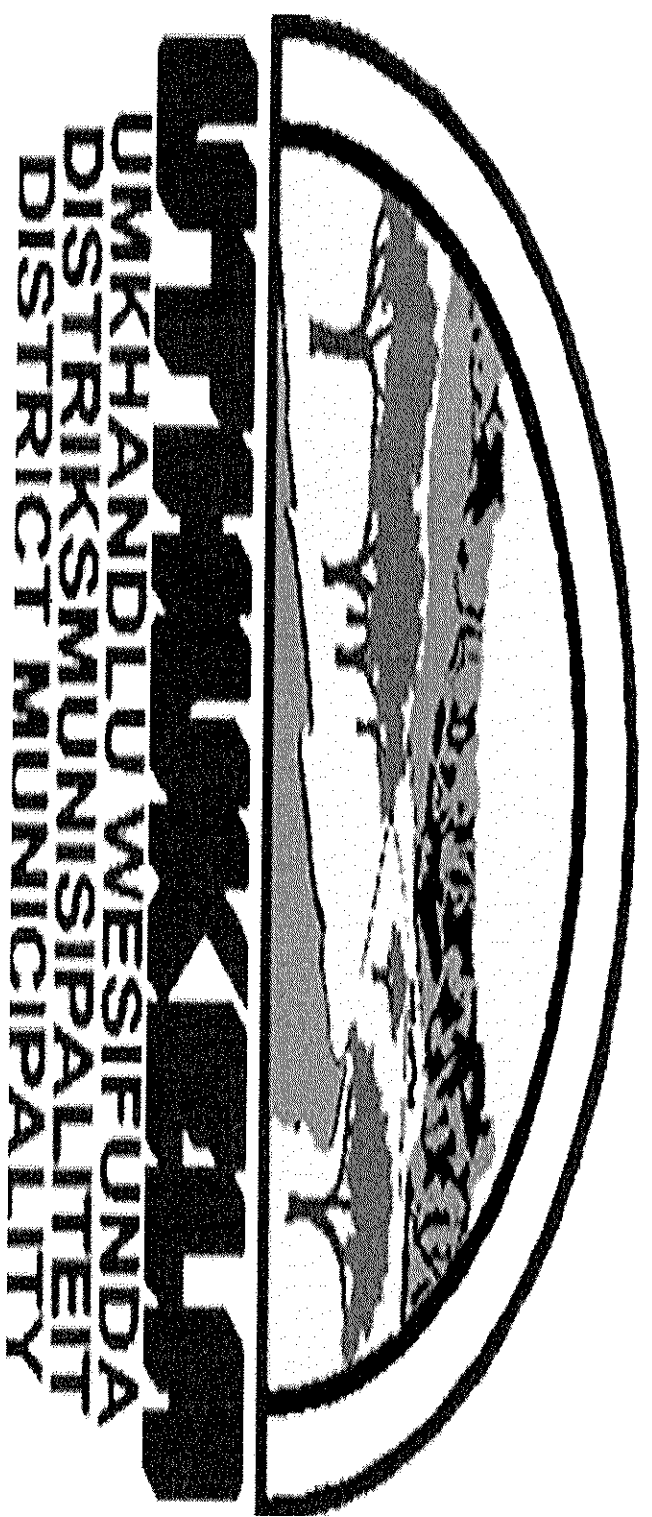

# 2022/23 SERVICE DELIVERY AND BUDGET IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

## MAYOR'S FOREWORD

The Uthukela District Municipality presents its 2022/23 Service Delivery and Budget Implementation Plan (SDBIP) which gives effect to the 2022/23 Integrated Development Plan (IDP) and budget that were adopted by Council on the 29 May 2022.

The municipality will be spending its most of the total capital expenditure budget on social infrastructure development to address backlogs and upgrading of the existing infrastructure in the following priority areas:

1. Water Supply (Both Bulk and reticulation water supply),
2. Water Quality (Clean drinking water)
3. Sanitation (Provision of descent sanitation infrastructure)

However, of those identified above, Council prioritize the construction of the following for the financial under review:

1. Reticulations lines at KwaNobamba/Ezitendeni Community Water Supply;
2. Completion of Ekuvukeni Bulk Water Supply;
3. Construction of reticulation lines at Wembezi Water Conservation and Demand Management;
4. Completion of reticulation lines at Estcourt Industrial pipe lines;
5. Completion of reticulation lines at Bhhekuzulu/Ephangwini Phase 3 & 4;
6. Completion of designs for Ladysmith AC pipeline replacement, Loskop ward 4 reticulation, Langkloof Package Plant, Bergville Water Treatment Works, Colenso WTW and Moyeni/Zwelisha Plant upgrade;
7. Refurbishment of Waste Water and Water infrastructure;
8. Completion of VIP toilets completed- District Wide; and
9. Drilling and equipping of production boreholes and hand pumps

Water remains a high priority for the District hence the highest budget to address bulk water supply. The municipality is committed to delivering services and thus contributing towards addressing key priority issues of the municipality through the implementation of the 2022/23 SDBIP. Furthermore, as a municipality, we strive to work together with our communities and stakeholders in working towards becoming a "Service Delivery Excellence".

The 2022/23 SDBIP for the UTM has been divided into two (2) layers, which are the organizational (top) layer and Departmental layer. The organizational layer of the SDBIP will be used to report to stakeholders including the Auditor General, National and Provincial Departments etc. The top layer will be published and made available to communities and all other relevant stakeholders. The departmental SDBIP will feed into the organizational (top) layer SDBIP and will be used internally.

The 2022/23 Service Delivery and Budget Implementation Plan (SDBIP) is therefore approved in line with Section 53 (1) (c) (ii) of Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003.

## INTRODUCTION

In terms of Section 53, (1) (c) (ii) of the Municipal Finance Management Act, Act No 53 of 2003, the Service Delivery Budget and Implementation Plan is defined as a detailed plan approved by the Mayor of a Municipality for implementing the Municipality's delivery of municipal services and its annual budget, and must indicate the following:

- (a) Projections for each month of –
  - (i) Revenue to be collected, by source; and
  - (ii) Operational and capital expenditure, by vote.
- (b) Service delivery targets and performance indicators for each quarter, and
- (c) Any other matters prescribed.

According to Section 53(c) (ii) of the Municipal Finance Management Act, the Mayor is expected to approve the Service Delivery Budget Implementation Plan within 28 days after the approval of the budget.

In terms of the provisions of the MFMA, the processes for the submission, approval, implementation and revision of the Service Delivery and Budget Implementation Plan (SDBIP) are as follows:

The Mayor must, upon receiving the reports listed in section 71 and 72, check whether the budget is implemented in accordance with the SDBIP and make revisions with council's approval for an adjustment budget and changes to the performance indicators in the budget and SDBIP, issue instructions to the Municipal Manager to ensure the Budget is implemented according to the SDBIP, submit the section 72 report to Council by 31 January of each year and make any revision to the SDBIP public promptly. ## PLANNING

During this phase the SDBIP process plan is developed, to be tabled with the IDP process plan. SDBIP related processes e.g. Workshop schedules, distribution of circulars and training workshops are also reviewed during this phase.

## **STRATEGIZING**

During this phase the IDP is reviewed and subsequent SDBIP programs and projects for the next five years based on Local, Provincial and National issues. Previous year's performance and current economic and demographic trends etc.

## **TABLING**

SDBIP is tabled with the draft IDP and budget before Council. Consultation with the community and stakeholders of the IDP on the SDBIP is done through budget hearings and formal local, provincial and National inputs or responses are also considered in developing the final document

## **ADOPTION**

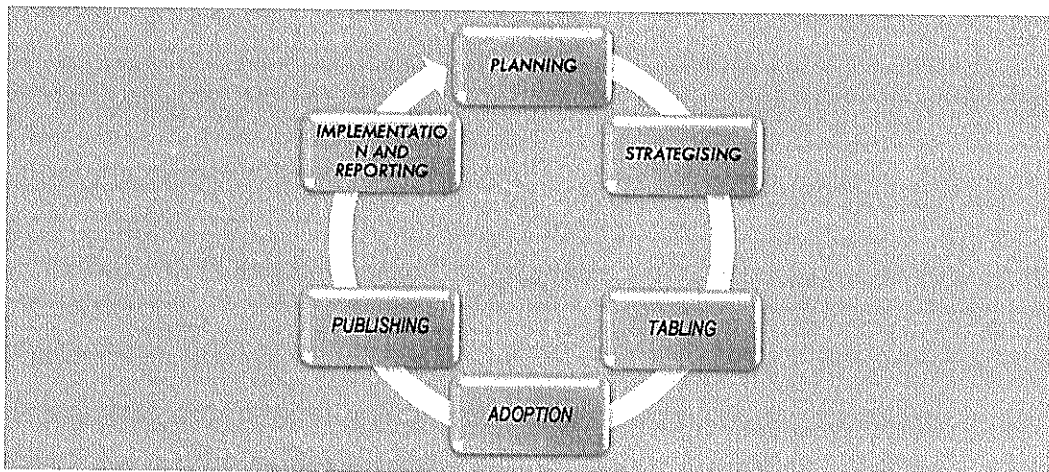
The Mayor approves the SDBIP no later than 28 days after the adoption of the Municipality's budget.

## **PUBLISHING**

The adopted SDBIP is made public and is published in the Municipal website

## **IMPLEMENTATION, MONITORING AND REPORTING**

SDBIP projects are implemented and quarterly reporting takes place. Mid-year reporting is done to assess performance on the SDBIP, the document is amended, where applicable and adopted by Council.



## **MONTHLY PROJECTIONS OF REVENUE TO BE COLLECTED FOR EACH SOURCE**

The failure to collect revenue as budgeted will severely impact on UThukela District Municipality's ability to provide services to the community. The Municipality therefore has to institute measures to achieve its monthly revenue targets for each source. These measures will enable the Municipality to assess its cash flow on a monthly basis with a view to undertaking contingency plans should there be a cash flow shortage or alternatively invest surplus cash. Furthermore, the effectiveness of credit control policies and procedures can be monitored with appropriate action taken if considered necessary.

## **MONTHLY PROJECTIONS OF EXPENDITURE AND REVENUE FOR EACH VOTE**

The monthly projection of revenue and expenditure per vote relate to the cash paid and reconciles with the cash flow statement adopted with the budget. The focus under this component is a monthly projection per vote in addition to projections by source. When reviewing budget projections against actual, it is useful to

consider revenue and expenditure per vote in order to gain a more complete picture of budget projections against actuals.

**Quarterly Projections of Service Delivery Targets and Performance Indicators for each Vote**

*This component of the SDBIP requires non-financial measurable performance objectives in the form of service delivery targets and other indicators of performance. The focus is on outputs rather than inputs. Service delivery targets relate to the level and standard of service being provided to the community and include the addressing of backlogs in basic services. The approach encouraged by National Treasury's MFMA Circular No. 13 is the utilization of scorecards to monitor service delivery.*

**DETAILED CAPITAL BUDGET OVER THREE YEARS**

*Information detailing infrastructural projects containing project description and anticipated capital costs over the three year period. The procurement process is an important component to ensure effective and timely infrastructure / capital service delivery.*
