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## Part 1 - Annual Budget

#### 1.1 Mayor's Report

The Monthly section 71 report is a report that gives a clear view on the state or performance of the Municipality for that month as well as the year to date performance. Among the impacts that are challenging the Municipality, is the cash flow challenge currently being experienced by the municipality due to among other things declining collection, historic expenditure patterns, high water losses and high rate of indigents within the municipal boundaries.
